Fourth in a series of "Don't Hug Me" musicals, DON'T HUG ME, I'M PREGNANT returns to the little north woods bar "The Bunyan" in Bunyan Bay, Minnesota, owned by Gunner and Clara Johnson. Also returning are the wonderful characters, new terrific original songs, great choreography and belly-filled laughs.

Our story begins with placid Gunner (Patrick Foley) and wacky friend Kannute (Bert Emmett) having their 11am "first beer" of the day. 8-1/2 months pregnant Clara (Rebekah Dunn) comes in out of the increasing snow storm (or as Kannute so eloquently puts it "Snownomami, Snowlacost, Snowcastrophe") with party supplies for her Baby Shower set to take place later that day in the bar. Gunnar, who doesn't seem to be the least bit interested in either Clara's pregnancy or baby shower, was supposed to get the bar ready for the party, but is almost three sheets to the wind with Kannute and trying to avoid the situation altogether. Clara's best friend, Bernice (Natalie Lander) arrives and Kannute can't control his attraction for her. But Bernice only has eyes for nerdy Aarvid (Greg Barnett) who is unaware of Bernice's intentions. So you see there is a lot going on here. But I don't want to give too much away. You will have too much fun seeing it for yourself.

Nothing is held back in the characterization of these characters. The audience roars with laughter and Phil Olson's Book and Lyrics, Paul Olson's music, Doug Engalla's direction, and Stan Mazin's choreography and all the talented actors are what make this extraordinarily great fun.

For those of you who haven't attended the first three plays in this series which began in 2003, a little background here: All the "Don't Hug Me" stories are set in "The Bunyan", what we here in Southern California would imagine as your "typical in the middle of nowhere" north woods bar (fantastically designed and constructed by Chris Winfield). All the characters return from each of the previous plays of "DON'T HUG ME", "A DON'T HUG ME CHRISTMAS CAROL", and "A DON'T HUG ME COUNTY FAIR".

This is a superb ensemble cast with each actor becoming the essence of their character. I thoroughly enjoyed all the original songs, as well as the hysterically funny story and script. This was my first encounter with "DON'T HUG ME" stories, and now I'm hooked and can't wait for the next one. For those of you that love silly, funny and entertaining evenings out, this is for you.
